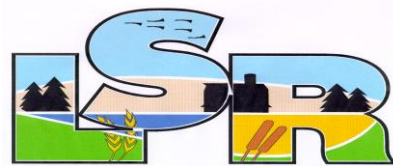

**RE: Pipeline Plow Program for 2017-2018**

Please find enclosed an application form for the LSRCD's Pipeline Plow Program. The shallow, buried pipeline can help to improve pasture utilization and protect riparian areas. The pipeline is connected to an existing water supply and transports clean, fresh water to where it is needed. The primary use of the pipelines is for livestock watering. By providing an alternative source of water, livestock are kept out of rivers, creeks, lakes, and wetlands. Water lines enable water to be pumped to areas where a water supply does not exist or dries up.

Program costs include the rental of the pipeline plow at \$100 per day and the cost of pipe at \$0.60 per foot (subject to change) and the cost of fittings. District staff will assist with burying the pipe and installing fittings.

## **Conditions:**

### **The Conservation District shall:**

1. Determine application priorities in consultation with Sub-District and Board members and staff.
2. Reserve the right to reasonable access to the project area for inspection, survey, construction, and tours of the project site.
3. Provide a shallow pipeline plow with one conservation district staff member during use.
4. Supply pipe of no greater than 2.0" diameter.
5. Transport plow and required materials to the project site.
6. Accept only applications made in the name of the registered landowner.
7. Reserve the right to refuse any application.
8. Provide assistance for projects on land within the Little Saskatchewan River Conservation District.
9. Use information provided by the applicant for LSRCD purposes solely.

### **The applicant shall:**

1. Provide reasonable access for inspection, survey, construction, and tours as requested by the LSRCD.
2. Provide an equipment rental fee of \$100.00 per day plus the cost of pipe, at \$0.60 per foot, (subject to change) and the cost of fittings to the LSRCD.
3. Provide and operate a tractor capable of pulling the pipeline plow.
  - a. Approximately 90 horse power
  - b. Four hydraulic points (Pioneer Ends)
4. Be eligible to apply to the LSRCD Nutrient Management Program for expenses related to the hose and fittings only.
5. Grant the conservation district the right to use any information related to this project for educational or promotional purposes.
6. Indemnify and save harmless the Little Saskatchewan River Conservation District, their agents, engineers, servants and/or employees from any and all actions, claims, suits, damages, injuries, or other loss no matter howsoever arising as a result of the construction, operation or maintenance of the project.
7. Notify the LSRCD in the event of a change in ownership or renter, the LSRCD ask that they be notified and be able to approach new landowner/renter to continue the project.

### **General Terms and Conditions:**

- Subject to the above terms, the agreement shall become effective and shall be binding upon both parties.
- If either party fails to meet the above-mentioned responsibilities, the party via written notice may terminate the agreement.
- The annual projects resulting from this program will be subject to funds appropriated.
- Technical service will be subject to the availability of staff. The LSRCD reserves the right to establish priorities for providing such services and assistance.
- Failure of Landowner to meet Landowner Conditions may negate him/her from other Conservation District programs.
- Only one application per landowner per year.
