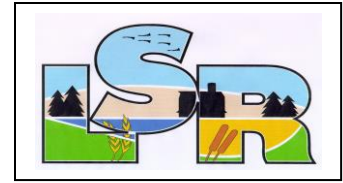

CONDITIONS:

The Conservation District shall:

1. Coordinate transport and set-up of the equipment.
2. Reserve the right to waive the \$100.00 damage deposit.
3. Reserve the right to refuse use of the equipment.
4. Reserve the right to charge a penalty of \$50.00 per day to applicants who unnecessarily delay the use of the equipment by another landowner. The penalty will be charged after the equipment has been in the landowner's possession longer than 2 days. Weather will be taken into consideration prior to the application of penalty.
5. Reserve the right to refuse participation by the applicant in other LSRCD programs due to failure of landowner to meet applicant conditions.

The applicant shall:

1. Agree to care for the equipment in a reasonable and prudent manner.
2. Provide \$8.00 per acre or a minimum \$100. fee as rent for the equipment.
3. Provide \$50.00 per day as payment of a penalty in the unnecessarily delayed use of the equipment.
4. Agree to pay a damage deposit of \$100.00, which will be returned once the equipment is returned undamaged to the District.
5. Provide and operate a tractor (approximately 80 hp) capable of pulling drill.
6. Be responsible for missing and/or damaged parts other than normal wear and tear of equipment.
7. Identify and save harmless the Little Saskatchewan River Conservation District, their agents, engineers, servants and/or employees from any and all actions, claims, suits, damages, injuries, or other loss no matter howsoever arising as a result of the construction, operation or maintenance of the project.
8. **Report** any problems resulting from equipment **malfunction** to the LSRCD **immediately**.

General Terms and Conditions:

- Subject to the above terms, the agreement shall become effective and shall be binding upon both parties
- If either party fails to meet the above-mentioned responsibilities, the party via written notice may terminate the agreement.
- The annual projects resulting from this program will be subject to funds appropriated.
- Technical service will be subject to the availability of staff. The district reserves the right to establish priorities for providing such services and assistance.
- Failure of Landowner to meet Landowner Responsibilities may negate him/her from other Conservation District programs.
