## QUANTITY OF TREES

### RECOMMENDED TREE AND SHRUB SPACING FOR SHELTERBELTS

**Deciduous shrubs** – at least 1.0 m (3 ft.) apart

**Deciduous trees** –at least 2.5 m (8 ft.) apart

**Coniferous trees** – at least 3.5 m (12 ft.) apart

### TREE QUANTITY CALCULATOR EXAMPLE

| Deciduous SHRUBS | Description   | Cost per Bundle* | # of Bundles | TOTAL |
|------------------|---|------------------|--------------|-------|
| Villosa Lilac    | A non-suckering medium shrub. Best growth occurs on moist, medium textured soils. Clusters of rosy-lilac to white flowers appear in mid to late June. Can reach a height of 12-14 ft.                               | \$ 34.00         |              |       |
| Caragana         | Very hardy, medium to tall, upright shrub, which can reach 12 to 14 feet in height on favorable sites. Tolerant of dry soils and high pH. Yellow flowers followed by seed bearing pods.                             | \$ 32.50         |              |       |
| Dogwood          | Medium sized, multi-stemmed shrub that may reach up to 6-8 ft in height. Prefers moist soils. White flower clusters appear in early June, followed by small, non-edible white berries.                              | \$ 32.50         |              |       |
| Saskatoon        | Small, hardy shrub that may reach a height of 4-10ft. White blossoms appear in early spring, in late summer it produces delicious fruit and in fall its leaves turn pale to deep scarlet                            | \$ 32.50         |              |       |
| Sea Buckthorn    | Thick, thorny, medium to tall shrub that may reach 12-16 ft in height. Tolerant of dry soils and salinity. The fruit, forms in clusters along the stems, and are ripe when orange in late August to early September | \$ 27.50         |              |       |

| Bur Oak         | Medium to large, adaptable, long-lived tree with a wide, spreading crown which may reach a height of 40-60 feet on favorable sites. Produces acorns which are utilized by a wide variety of wildlife. | \$ 31.00          |              |       |
| Golden Willow   | Moisture loving, large spreading tree. May reach up to 40-50 ft when mature. Young stems are a bright yellow. The fastest growing willow species.   | \$ 29.25          |              |       |

| Green Ash              | Medium to large straight trunked tree reaching 35 to 50 ft in height. Tolerant of wet or dry soil conditions, but requires full sun and is not shade tolerant.  | \$ 27.75 |  |  |
| Hybrid Poplar          | As yet unnamed superior clones from the populus testing program at the ARS Northern Great Plains Research Laboratory at Mandan, ND. Selected for insect and disease resistance, growth and hardiness. | \$ 29.25 |  |  |
| MB Maple               | Native tree species found throughout southern Manitoba and Saskatchewan. May reach a height of 40-45 ft. Adapted to a wide range of growing conditions.   | \$ 31.00 |  |  |
| Hybrid Poplar Cuttings | <b>8" - 10" stick with no roots.</b> Fast growing, hardy, with a spread of 8-10 ft. Selected for cold & drought tolerance and disease & pest resistance.<br><b>(Bundles of 25)</b>                    | \$ 17.50 |  |  |
| Acute Willow Cuttings  | <b>8" - 10" stick with no roots.</b> Medium sized, multi-stemmed tree that performs best on moist, well-drained sites.<br><b>(Bundles of 25)</b>  | \$ 17.50 |  |  |

| Coniferous TREES | Description  | Cost per Bundle* | # of Bundles | TOTAL |
|------------------|--|------------------|--------------|-------|
| Ponderosa Pine   | A large tree with a straight trunk & wide, irregularly cylindrical crown. Can grow up to 35 m (115 ft) tall. It is a hard, wind firm tree with a wide-spreading root system. Shade intolerant, prefers moist, well drained loam soils, but will tolerate sandy soils as well as saline and alkaline soils. | \$ 38.00         |              |       |
| Colorado Spruce  | A hardy, drought resistant conifer with a pyramid shape. Requires full sunlight and prefers moist, well – drained sandy and loam soils. Protection is required during establishment. Needles are a dark green/blue green colour.   | \$ 39.25         |              |       |
| White Spruce     | A medium tree, very dense and pyramidal when young. Can grow up to 60 ft in height. It grows best on moist loam soils and requires full sunlight.  | \$ 39.25         |              |       |
